**SPECIAL SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE FUNDS**

10 2. ~~Any funds derived from the sale of empty containers shall be deposited in the~~  
11 ~~school centralized lunch fund and earmarked for the respective schools.~~

12 3. ~~Any discounts or rebates on school food service purchases shall be deducted from~~  
13 ~~the vendor's statement.~~
